## Homily 3rd Easter Sunday

On the very day of the Resurrection, two disciples leave the community, disappointed and sad, and walk toward Emmaus, which means “the place of hot baths.” In other words, they have allowed disappointment and discouragement to cool their hearts, so they look for something else, something different from Jesus, to comfort their sadness.

Life can bring disappointments and struggles, but if we let ourselves be overcome by them, we close our hearts and lose the ability to see that Jesus is walking with us.

The story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus is also the story of what happens in the celebration of the Mass.

We, as disciples of Christ, walk with heavy hearts, tired from daily struggles, or in need of warmth and encouragement. Yet, Jesus Risen comes to meet us.

First, as in every Eucharistic celebration, Jesus speaks to them through the Scriptures:

“Beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he explained to them what referred to him in all the Scriptures.”

Even though they were slow of heart and lacking understanding, Jesus patiently and lovingly evangelized them again.

Jesus prepares the most special moment of that encounter by helping them understand the Word of God, so that, longing for his presence, they could say:

“Stay with us, Lord.”

Then, with hearts burning within them, they recognized the Risen Jesus in the breaking of the bread.

The Christian faith is built on this foundation: Word and Sacraments.

That is why today’s Gospel invites us to reflect on how we listen to the Word of God.

Does the Bible still make our hearts burn?

If the Word of God is not my comfort and strength, then where do I go? What warms my heart?

The sacrament of the Eucharist is, above all, the place where I encounter the living Jesus who is always by my side. But how do I prepare myself so that the Holy Mass becomes a true and deep encounter that fills my life?

When I feel disappointed in life, in my faith, or even in God, do I turn to the Eucharist to recognize the true face of Jesus, to be renewed and return to the center of my faith?

May this Easter help us to be disciples on a journey—not on the road away like Emmaus, but on the road of proclaiming that Jesus is alive and wants to meet us.

For the Christian experience to be genuine, it must be an encounter with the living God, and it must become a missionary experience, like the disciples who proclaimed:  
"The Lord has truly been raised!"
